Repeal Closed Primaries

AN ACT

Section 1. Amending the Pennsylvania Election Code to allow those who are registered as an independent voter to vote in primary election.

Section 2. Definitions

- a. "Independent voter." An unaffiliated voter who does not align themselves with a political party.

Section 2. Independent voters will choose either a Republican ballot or Democrat ballot to cast their vote on. They will not be able to choose from both ballots.

Section 3. Effective date. This act will take effect on January 1, 2026.
